Directions and Parking Information:

The Carlos Museum is located at 571 S. Kilgo Circle, Atlanta, GA 30322. The entrance to the University is located on the roundabout at the intersections of North Decatur and Oxford Roads.

Suggested parking decks are the Oxford Road Parking Deck, which can be entered by making the first left turn after entering the campus at the roundabout or the Fishburne deck, which can be accessed by making the first right turn after entering campus.
